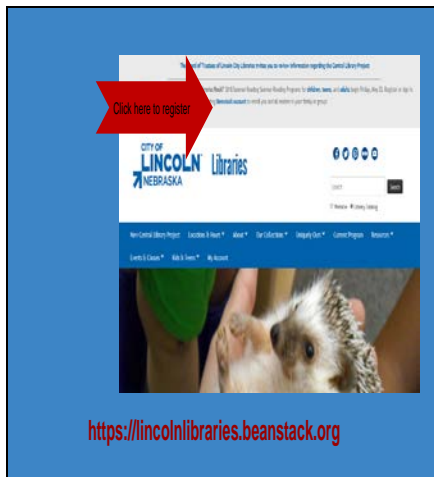


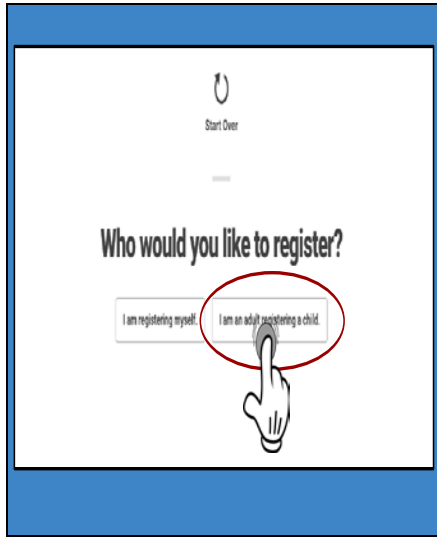
You will need a Beanstack account to sign up for reading programs like the Summer Reading Program offered by the Lincoln City Libraries. Although not required, you can also track your reading progress in Beanstack. Here is how you set up a Beanstack account for your children and yourself.



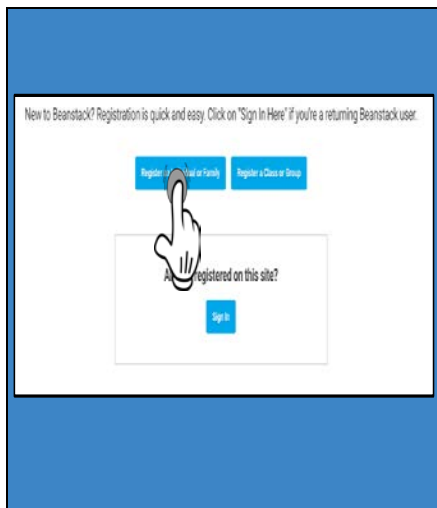
You will begin at the Lincoln City Libraries website: lincolnlibraries.org. Click on “Beanstack.” Click on “Register.”



Choose Register an Individual or Family



Click on “I am an adult registering a child.”



Then click “Register an Individual or Family.”

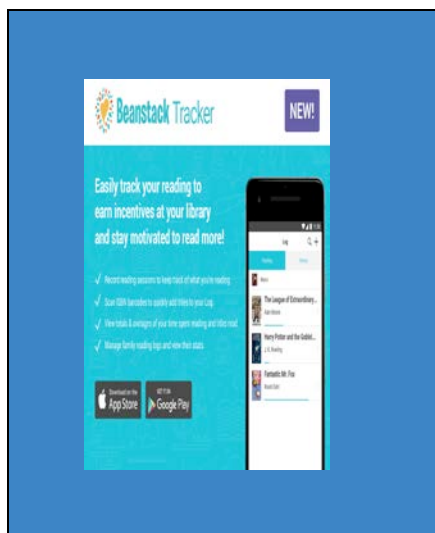
