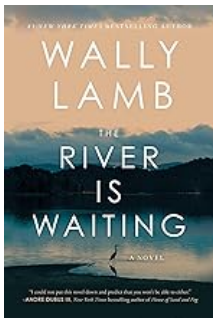


Fever Beach: A Novel

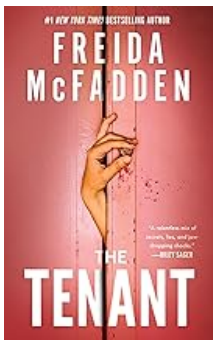


The River is Waiting: A Novel

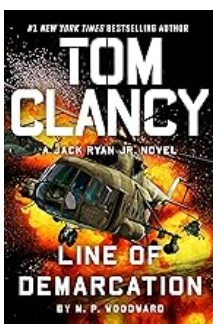


The Tenant
