

AARP Tax-Aide Services

AARP Tax-Aide has several options for providing taxpayer assistance. Returns will be prepared from February 1 through April 16. These options vary by location and are subject to change. Visit <https://www.aarpfoundation.org/taxaide> for more details.

- Same Day In Person Drop-Off: Appointments must be scheduled in advance. Taxpayer remains onsite until return is completed. No walk-ins except for questions.
- Details for making appointments are available on a locator service found at <https://www.aarpfoundation.org/taxaide>. **Appointment scheduling will begin on January 14, 2023.** Most returns can be completed within 60 – 90 minutes.
- You can also dial 211 to reach the United Way Helpline for assistance in scheduling an appointment.

- Beatrice site:
 - **Beatrice Public Library**: Wednesdays and Saturdays 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
 - Call 402-520-7409 for appointments.
- When entering one of our sites, you are acknowledging that you have not tested positive for COVID-19, flu or RSV or been in close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19, flu or RSV in the past 10 days.

Likewise, by entering one of our sites, you are acknowledging that you are not experiencing COVID-19, flu or RSV symptoms, including without limitation, fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea nor vomiting and diarrhea.

- **Virtual Tax Preparation**: Taxpayers interact with Tax-Aide’s IRS-certified tax counselors online or by phone and exchange documents electronically. Start the process at <https://www.aarpfoundation.org/taxaide> to search for “**Nebraska Virtual Site**”.
