Lincoln City Libraries provides Home Outreach by Mail services to homebound patrons who would like to access library materials. We will mail books, CDs, DVDs, and/or magazines to your home at no cost to you. You can receive up to five items, limited by what will fit in the bag. Temporary Home Outreach by Mail must be for a period of at least six months. When a patron is utilizing Home Outreach services, they are not allowed to use any in-person library services, but they are allowed to use e-services such as Hoopla or Libby as well as receiving their materials through the mail.
